Communication Efforts

The Southwest Region provided for regular, meaningful, two-way communication with parents, family, and community through monthly Parent Advisory Committee meetings held at the Region Center where the Region Superintendent attended and addressed issues and concerns that parents/guardians had regarding the educational process. Researchers were brought in to demonstrate how parents could help students be academically successful in school.

All Southwest Region secondary schools and many elementary schools maintain a telephone and/or on-line student information system which supplies parents with current information about their child's academic performance and attendance as well as opportunities to collaborate with teachers. Region specific information including student learning and achievement goals can be found on a regularly updated web site and incorporated into articles in each school's newsletter during the school year.

Public Meetings

The Southwest Region held 15 public meetings during the 2006-2007 school year. Public meetings included nine Parent Advisory Committee Meetings conducted by the Region Superintendent, four School Board Representative Parent Advisory Council (PAC) meetings, a School Board Community Linkage Forum, and two AZAC meeting to discuss zoning issues. In addition to these, region administration attended meetings at various schools in the Southwest Region to address concerns and celebrate accomplishments.
