Mission Statement

Shadow Ridge High School's mission is to empower students to become educated, productive, and responsible citizens in a diverse world.

Principal's Highlights

Shadow Ridge High School students have the opportunity to complete graduation requirements while enrolling in a variety of elective courses which enable them to explore various career opportunities.

- Eighteen students were designated as Nevada High School Scholars.
- Twenty-nine students were designated as recipients of the Presidential Award for Educational Excellence.
- \$1,540,000.00 in Millennium Scholarships was awarded.
- After-school tutoring sessions were offered to assist students in the area of mathematics.
- Algebra I students were enrolled in corresponding Math Fundamentals to provide math instruction daily on the block schedule.
- Non-proficient seniors attended Math Camps prior to taking the HSPE and demonstrated a pass rate of 75%.
- Computer-based programs including Criterion Writing, READ 180, and Moogie Math were used to enhance student achievement.
- Marzano's High-Yield Strategies were utilized in all core classes to support instruction.
- SRHS captured the Sunset Regional Championship in softball and the 4A State Championship in men's volleyball.

Goals and Objectives

Goal 1

Improve ELA achievement for all students in grades 10 and 11 as measured by the NHSPE in writing

Objective(s):

The overall percentage of students passing the Nevada High School Proficiency Exam (NHSPE) in writing shall increase from 78.6% to 83.6%.

Goal 2

Improve math achievement for non-proficient students, with emphasis on IEP students as measured by the NHSPE

Objective(s):

The percentage of students in the IEP subgroup passing the Nevada High School Proficiency Exam (NHSPE) in mathematics shall increase from 12.0% to 22.0%.

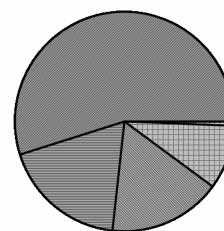

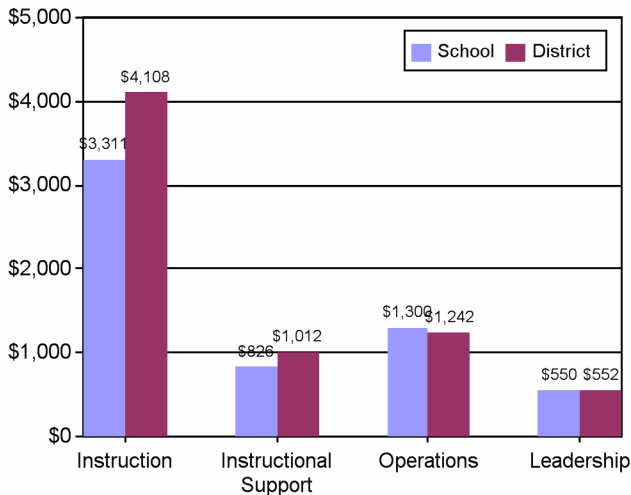
